A LETTER FROM CEO DAVID MARVIN

Time to highlight outstanding results achieved on the development and asset management side of our enterprise. This team of professionals that offices on the 3rd floor of Restaurant Row and CPW's mezzanine level do terrific work,

often behind the scenes. The common thread in the results is that each undertaking required sustained effort, patience, and know-how.

- On our 20th anniversary of the Embassy Suites at Centennial Olympic Park's development/opening, we arranged long-term, conventional debt that will be supportive of owning this flagship asset for many years to come. This transaction capped our group's ambitious, five-year campaign that encompassed buying out our Chinese and Hilton partners, installing Legacy Ventures as hotel manager, arranging interim financings, and completing an \$8 million renovation.
- This quarter, we are finally breaking ground on the 186-room Hyatt House Hotel project in Atlanta's Central Perimeter area that we have been navigating entitlement issues on for over 3 years. Our hotel will be the only hotel within the Medical District and is a Transit Oriented Development (TOD) located next to a MARTA station. Upon its completion in 2021, this outstanding project will be operated by Legacy Ventures.
- Also this quarter, we finish development and open Dos Bocas, a successor restaurant to Legal Sea Foods in downtown Atlanta. Dos Bocas is LV's restaurant team's fun and creative concept that celebrates Tex-Mex and Cajun cuisines. LV's design and construction group have created a beautiful space. Equally important, Dos Bocas unifies Legacy Pavilion's primary restaurant space with the F&B operations of the Hilton Garden Inn, Game-X and Ventanas. This creates an expanded and more compelling offering for our customers and guests.

The great architect, IM Pei, said that "Success is a collection of problems solved." Legacy Ventures' development and asset management team is constantly solving problems, meeting opportunities and working with our operations teams in building a legacy of accomplishment.

WORKSTYLE CORNER



BRAIN STRAINED? HIT REFRESH!

Our brain works in two primary modes: 'focused' and 'diffused'. Research confirms what we can often sense - but may choose to ignore - that there is a limit to our focused mode. The more we strain our brain to complete a complex task, the more we increase internal tension resulting in a restriction of our creative thinking and an amplification of our error rate.

The solution is twofold. First, pay attention when you are hitting a dead end. Studies show that you can reduce internal tension by up to 50% by simply noticing and naming your overloaded state. Then, once you've acknowledged it, activate strategies to shift into 'diffused' or 'refresh' mode.

Given that circumstances vary, create a set of 'refresh' strategies to choose from (your tired brain is not going to be much use for creative ideas at the point of overload). One of the best go-to strategies is to take deep breaths and walk around. Shifting your physical position works on a neurological level to help your brain start to recalibrate. Deep breathing helps reduce your stress hormones that are firing up your urgency to 'figure it out!' from a narrowed perspective.

Dare I say, letting your mind wander can be a great refresh strategy? Listen to music, check out the clouds, grab something to drink, do something 'mindless' (unproductive!). These activities allow your mind to access other parts of your brain that shut down under stress.

Unconvinced? Do a test run. Try solving a word or number puzzle. Stop when you hit a blank. Shift to refresh mode (but don't short cut the time required for a true refresh.) Return to the puzzle - presto! You are almost guaranteed to see a solution that is so 'obvious' you might want to kick yourself for not seeing it before.

Brain science proves the old adage: "I need to sleep on it."

TOMATO, WATERMELON AND CUCUMBER SALAD WITH FETA AND BASIL

COURTESY OF CHEF CHRISTOPHER BLOBAUM Serves:6-8 people

Ingredients:

1 cup cubed red watermelon
1 cup cubed yellow watermelon
1 cup sliced heirloom tomatoes
1 cup sliced cucumber
½ cup feta cheese, goat or cow's milk

4 cup basil leaves
2 tablespoons mint leaves

¼ cup white balsamic vinegar 1 tablespoon lemon juice (optional) ½ cup extra virgin olive oil sea salt to taste

Method:

In a mixing bowl, whisk together vinegar, lemon juice and olive oil. Add all other ingredients. Toss and allow to chill for one hour before serving.
